

Privacy Notice pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR)

The ICSC Foundation - National Research Centre for High Performance Computing, Big Data and Quantum Computing, in its capacity as Data Controller, hereby informs you, pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, that the personal data collected in the context of the management of participant registrations for the International School on the Open Science Cloud (hereinafter SOSOC) will be processed in accordance with the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, and protection of your privacy and rights, in full compliance with current legislation on the protection of personal data. This Privacy Notice applies exclusively to the processing activities carried out by the ICSC Foundation in connection with the management of registrations for the SOSOC.

1. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

The Data Controller is the ICSC Foundation - National Research Centre for High Performance Computing, Big Data and Quantum Computing, represented by its Director General, Dr Daniela Gabellini, with its registered office at Via Magnanelli 2 - 40033 Casalecchio di Reno (BO), Tax Code 91449080372 and VAT No. 04298151202. 2. Purposes of processing, legal bases, and retention period

Personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- a) Administration, management, and organisation of participant enrolment for the International School on the Open Science Cloud

Legal basis: Performance of a contract to which the data subject is party (Article 6(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679);

Retention period: proportionate to the underlying purposes and, subsequently, for the period provided for by the applicable administrative, accounting, and tax legislation.

- b) Newsletter activities and the sending of training materials and commercial communications

Legal basis: Expression of consent (Art. 6(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679)

Retention period: until consent is withdrawn.

3. Types of data processed

For the purposes set out in this policy, the Data Controller may process the following categories of personal data:

- a) Identification and contact details, such as first name and surname, residential address, tax reference number, telephone number, and e-mail address.
- b) Administrative, accounting, and payment data necessary for managing registrations, processing payments, and fulfilling related administrative and tax obligations.

4. Methods of processing

For the purposes of managing and finalising registrations, the Data Controller uses the Indico platform.

The newsletter management and delivery service is provided via the MailUp platform.

The data you provide will be processed by the Data Controller, including with the support of external service providers, in electronic or paper form, through the organisation and processing of data, in relation to the purposes set out in paragraph 2, and in any case supported by data security and confidentiality safeguards, in full compliance with the appropriate technical and organisational measures pursuant to Article 32 of EU Regulation 2016/679.

5. Provision of data

For the purposes set out in paragraph 2(a), the provision of personal data by participants is mandatory to enter into the contractual relationship. Failure to provide personal data, or the provision of incomplete or inaccurate data, may result in the registration process not being completed and may prevent participation in the SOSOC. Conversely, the provision of data for the purposes referred to in paragraph 2(b) is optional and may be withdrawn at any time by sending a notice to the DPO of the ICSC Foundation at the email address: dpo@supercomputing-icsc.it.

6. Disclosure to third parties

Your personal data may be disclosed to other bodies involved in the Initiative, such as the National Institute of Nuclear Physics (INFN); Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna (UNIBO), and the University of Perugia (UNIPG), which act as independent data controllers for the processing operations falling within their respective remit.

Your data may also be disclosed to public bodies authorised by law to request such data, as well as, exclusively for the purposes set out in this notice, to third-party companies or professionals (acting as Data Controllers or designated as Data Processors pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 28 of EU Regulation 2016/679) whom the Data Controller engages to carry out its activities, such as, by way of example and without limitation, tax and accounting consultants, legal and sector-specific consultants, auditing firms, the Indico Platform, and software supply and support companies.

Please note that your personal data will not be disclosed or transferred to third countries (outside the EU). The list of third parties is available upon express request to the Data Controller.

7. Rights of data subjects

In accordance with Articles 15 et seq. of EU Regulation 2016/679, data subjects may at any time exercise the following rights against the Data Controller: a) **[right of access]** to access their personal data and obtain a copy thereof; b) **[right to rectification]** to have their data rectified if it is inaccurate, or to have it completed if it is incomplete; c) **[right to erasure]** to have their data erased in the cases provided for in Article 17 of EU Regulation 2016/679; d) **[right to restriction]** to have processing restricted in the cases provided for in Article 18 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679; e) **[right to data portability]** to receive the personal data concerning them in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and to request that the ICSC Foundation transmit such data to another data controller; f) **[right to object]** to object, at any time, on grounds relating to their particular situation, to the processing of data concerning them carried out pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) EU Regulation 2016/679, where applicable; g) **[right to lodge a complaint]** lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority pursuant to Article 77 of EU Regulation 2016/679.
